

## ***Call for one Professor in Computer Science***

*This document is an extract of the Rector Decree nr. 134/2023. Please consider that only the Italian version is the complete, official document. In case of discrepancies between the Italian version and the English version, the Italian version shall prevail.*

### ***Subject of this call***

1. The GSSI announces a selection procedure pursuant to Art. 18, par. 1, of Law no. 240/2010 for the recruitment of a Professor for the competitive sector 01/B1 (Computer Science), scientific-disciplinary sector INF/01 (Computer Science) to be funded by the project DIP\_ECCELLENZA\_MAT\_CS (CUP D13C22003740001).
2. The scientific commitment required from the Professor concerns research activities in the area of developing efficient and reliable distributed or autonomous systems. The Professor is required to have proven experience in managing competitive research projects and supervising PhD students.
3. The Professor is bound to comply with the obligations laid down in current legislation and the University Regulations on teaching, supplementary teaching and student services. In particular, the teaching commitment required to the Professor concerns the teaching of doctoral level courses, the direction of doctoral theses, the participation, where required, in selection and evaluation committees for students and postdocs, the scientific direction of postdocs, and the participation in academic bodies.
4. The maximum number of publications to be submitted is 15.
5. The language skills required of the candidate, in respect of the intended teaching requirements, relate to the ability to teach in English.

### ***Eligibility Requirements***

1. Candidates admitted to take part in the selection procedure must be:
  - a) scholars in possession of the national scientific qualification of the first level pursuant to Article 16 of Law no. 240/2010 for the competition sector in question, or for one of the competition sectors included in the same macro-sector, for the area covered by the procedure and for the functions corresponding to the one for which the selection is announced;
  - b) scholars who have obtained eligibility pursuant to Law no. 210/1998 for the disciplinary scientific sector that is the subject of the call for applications, or for one of the competition sectors included in the same macro-sector, for the category that is the subject of the procedure, limited to the period of eligibility;
  - c) Professors already working at other universities in the category corresponding to that for which the selection is announced;
  - d) scholars permanently engaged abroad in research or teaching activities at university level in positions at the same level as those covered by the call for applications, on the basis of tables of correspondence updated every three years, defined by the Ministry with Ministerial Decree no. 662 of 1.9.2016.

2. Those who have been excluded from the enjoyment of civil and political rights or from the active political electorate or have been dismissed or disqualified from employment in a public administration or have been declared disqualified from another public employment pursuant to Presidential Decree No. 3/1957 may not participate in the selection.
3. Furthermore, those who have a degree of kinship or affinity up to and including the fourth degree of kinship or marriage relationship with the Rector of GSSI, the Director General, a member of the Board of Directors or the Academic Senate, or a GSSI faculty member belonging to the relevant Scientific Area cannot participate in the selection process.
4. The requirements must be met by the deadline for submitting the application. Candidates are admitted subject to selection. Failure to meet the above-mentioned requirements or the existence of irremediable situations of incompatibility that make it impossible to enter the selection procedure or to fill the position in accordance with the Internal Regulations and current legislation in force entails exclusion from the selection, which will be ordered by justified decision of the Rector.

#### *Application, attachments and deadline for participating in the selection*

1. The application for admission to the procedure, together with the attachments referred to in point 10 of this article, must be submitted, under penalty of exclusion, only via the online procedure accessible at the link <https://pica.cineca.it/gssi/2023-po-001/domande> on the PICA platform (Piattaforma Integrata Concorsi di Ateneo - University Integrated Competitions Platform) **by and no later than 11:59 p.m. (Italian time) on the thirtieth day following the day of publication of the notice of competition in the Gazzetta Ufficiale - IV serie speciale - Concorsi ed Esami.**
2. No other form of submission of applications or documentation for participation in the procedure is accepted.
3. Access to the procedure is carried out exclusively after self-registration in the system by using an electronic mailbox, including non-certified mail.
4. The applicant must enter all the data required to produce the application and attach the documents in electronic .pdf format. The application for participation must be completed in full, as indicated in the online procedure, and must include a copy of a valid identity document, under penalty of exclusion. By the deadline for submitting the application, the system allows it to be saved as a draft so that it can be refined and sent at a later date.
5. If necessary, provided that the deadline for submission is met, it is also possible to withdraw an application already sent and submit a new one. The date of online submission of the application to take part in the selection is certified by the computer system by means of a receipt that will be automatically sent by e-mail to the address indicated by the candidate. Each application will be given an identification number which, together with the competition code indicated in the electronic application, must be specified for any subsequent communication. Once the submission deadline has expired, the system will no longer allow access and submission of the electronic form. **For reports of technical problems and requests for assistance, candidates should contact Cineca's technical support service via the link at the bottom of the GSSI/PICA home page (<https://pica.cineca.it/gssi/>). The GSSI shall not be held liable for any delays due to the fault of third parties, unforeseeable circumstances or force majeure.**
6. The procedures and deadlines referred to in this Article must also be observed for the submission of certificates and documents required to supplement and complete applications already submitted.

7. The declarations made in the application are deemed to be made in accordance with Presidential Decree No. 445/2000, as amended and supplemented, by candidates entitled to use the forms of simplification of administrative certifications as permitted by the aforementioned decree.
8. In addition to the other information required, candidates acknowledged to be disabled within the meaning of law no. 104/1992 must specify in their application to take part in the selection, under penalty of inapplicability of the benefit, the aid required in relation to their disability, producing a medical certificate specifying the essential elements relating to their condition, in order to enable the administration to prepare in good time the means and tools required to guarantee the benefits requested.
9. The application must also indicate the address that the candidate indicates for the purposes of the selection, including a telephone number and e-mail address. Any change in these must be promptly notified to the GSSI. The Administration accepts no liability for the loss of communications due to incorrect information on the applicant's address or for failure or delay in communicating a change in the address indicated in the application, nor for any postal or telematic errors or for mistakes in any case imputable to third parties, fortuitous events or force majeure.
10. In addition, each candidate must enclose with the application:
  - a. a copy of a valid identity document;
  - b. a curriculum vitae of his/her scientific and teaching activities, containing an overall and detailed list of all the qualifications possessed, teaching activities and scientific production;
  - c. a self-certification containing the list of his/her qualifications;
  - d. qualifications in .pdf format;
  - e. a self-certification containing the list of his/her publications;
  - f. publications in pdf format.
11. The admission of candidates to the procedure is subject to conditions. Exclusion for failure to meet the requirements may be ordered at any time during the procedure by justified decree of the Rector.
